PEOPLE'S BRIDGE

Peoples Bridge is an institution dedicated to defending the autonomous region of Northeast Syria and, beyond that, the territories of Kurdistan.

The revolution in Rojava, which has been ongoing for more than a decade and which puts progressive values such as **democratic self-determination, climate justice, women's liberation, and democracy** into practice, must be brought to Europe.

The revolution of **July 19** in Rojava has opened a new door on the path to freedom for the Kurdish, Arab, and other regional peoples.

It broke the chains of colonialism by implementing the democratic and liberal power and will of the peoples, by not supporting the reactionary forces under the conditions of the reactionary civil war.

Since Assad was overthrown by **HTS**, the Syrian branch of **Al Qaeda** supported by Western imperialists, regional powers and imperialists have been trying to get their hands on Syria's earthly and underground riches. This has also led to tensions between regional powers—such as between Turkey and Israel, which want to shape Syria according to their wishes in order to strengthen their influence in the region.

As migrants from the Middle East, workers, students, and progressives, we see it as our duty to defend the hope of all oppressed people in the world, which is reflected in the new social form in Rojava.

This means not only defending the revolution, but also supporting social reconstruction. Organizing solidarity with besieged Rojava/northeastern Syria, carrying out activities to strengthen the infrastructure of the revolution and organizing support for problems that require technical, logistical, and skilled labor remain among the main tasks of the time.

The Bridge of Peoples aims to strengthen solidarity with Kurdistan and organize a unity that can overcome the siege.

People's Bridge has set itself the goal of strengthening solidarity with Rojava/Northeast Syria and the unity of the peoples of the Middle East. Only in this way can we, as a united force of the oppressed, confront the incessant wars and massacres in the region.
